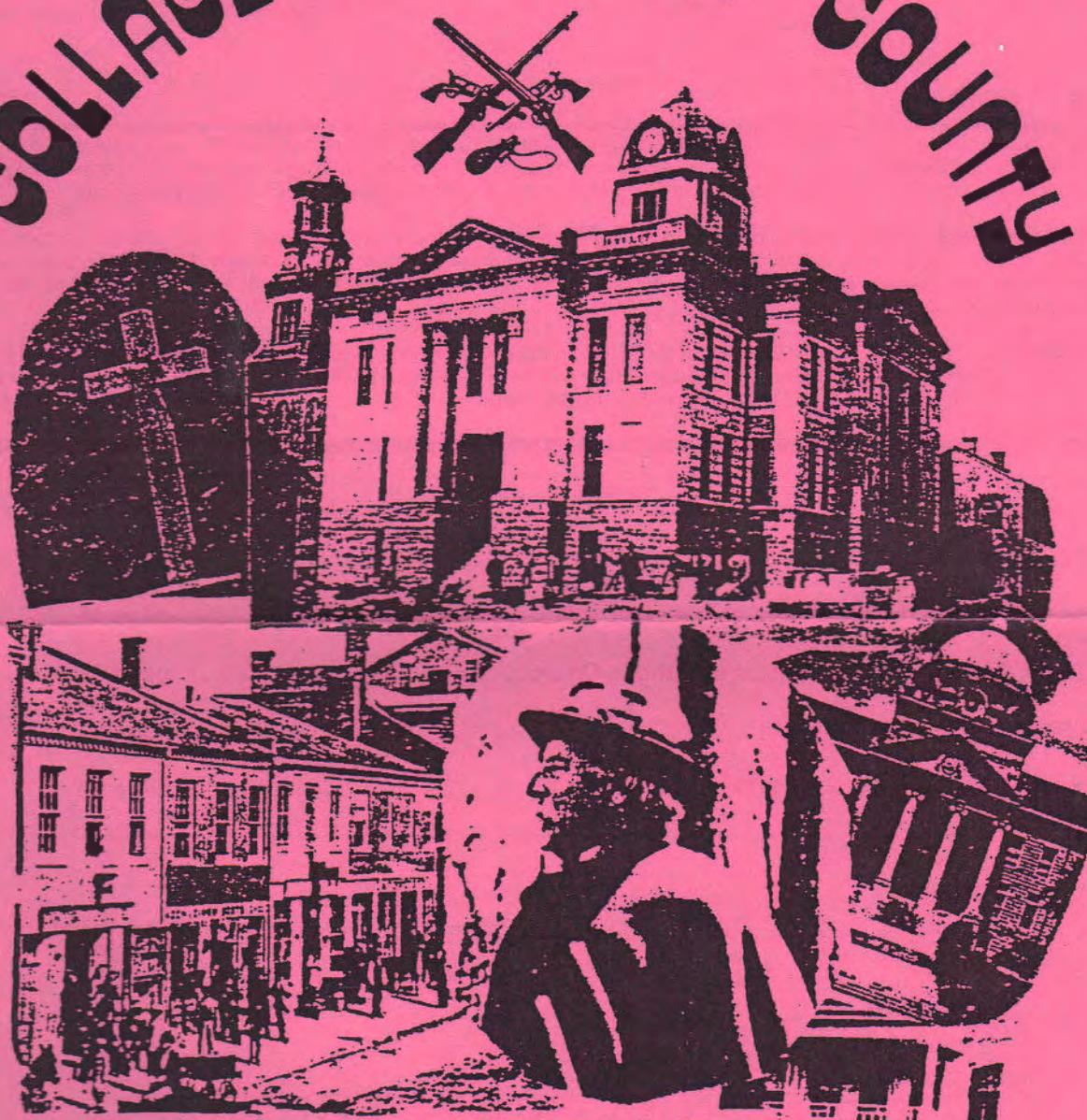


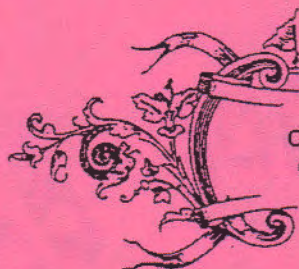

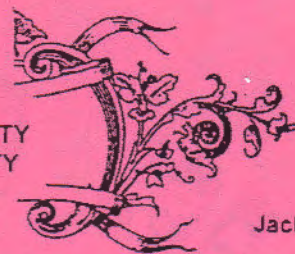

From the President

Dear Cape Girardeau County Genealogical Society Members,

I have sometimes heard from those of you who do not live in the immediate area, indicating that you would be willing to help with projects, but that this is not possible because you live too far away. There are actually a number of potential projects that can be done from anywhere—either because they involve online materials, or because they involve materials that could be copied and mailed to you. We are also open to any of your ideas for other projects—be they for production of publications, or improving the library. So.....if any of you are interested in helping out, the following are some projects that need one or more volunteers to see them through. Contact me if you have any interest in helping with any of these.

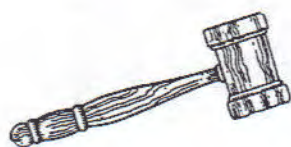
First of all, some projects can only be done locally, because they involve the library, or because they involve records that are in the County Archive Center:

- Serve on the Library Committee, and help keep the Society's library organized.
- Organize exchange quarterlies in the library. Most of these have been sorted into stacks, but they need more organization and an index to be more useful.
- Complete naturalizations book that Betty Mills began. Betty completed an index book, but she was part of the way through a more detailed book, in which she had transcribed court records to provide detailed information on naturalizations of those who immigrated to Cape Girardeau Co. in the 1800s.
- Abstract marriage records after 1910. We have books available, either through Jean Adams or the Society, for all marriages into part of 1910, but carrying these forward would add to an already excellent resource for Cape Girardeau Co.

Many other potential or ongoing projects can be done from anywhere, and can involve our out-of-town members.

- Reconcile death certificate records on Missouri State Archive website with local cemetery records. These certificates have been scanned on the state's website through about 1930. The cemetery is listed on most of them, and this needs to be matched against cemetery inventories that we have. This will allow us to list unmarked burials in these cemeteries.
- Reconcile Cape Girardeau County and City death records with cemetery records. Some death records were kept at the county level in the late 1880s-early 1890s, and city level through about 1930. Again, these need to be reconciled with cemetery inventories to pick out unmarked burials.
- Enter cemetery data from existing inventories into database program. I have a database program that is easier to use than the old one, and I think it would allow anyone to enter data. It is valuable to do this because a database program is far more flexible in terms of searching capabilities than just typing the records. I can provide the old inventories and the program if anyone is interested.
- Type/scan and index newspaper abstracts from old Cape Girardeau Co. newspapers. There are quite a number of abstracts that were done in the 1970s and 1980s by Society members. Most all of these are now generally unavailable. They need to be either scanned using text recognition software, or re-typed, and indexed to make them available and more valuable.

Know all men by these presents that we Saley Welker, Henry Yount, Henry Welker, and James Crawford all of the County of Cape Girardeau are held and firmly bound to William Clark Governor of the Territory of Missouri, or his successors in office in the sum of two thousand dollars for payment of whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, the thirty first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen.

The condition of this obligation is such that, if the within bounden Sally Welker administratrix & Henry Young administrator of all and singular the goods, chattels, rights, and credits of Peter Welker deceased do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels, rights, and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession, or knowledge of them the said Sally Welker & Henry Yount, or into the hands, and possession of any other person or persons, for them and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the office of the Circuit Court for the County of Cape Girardeau, at or before the thirdman[?] day of August next ensuring that the same goods, chattels, rights, and credits and all other the goods, chattels, rights, and credits of the said deceased, at the time of the death of the said deceased, which at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the said Sally Welker & Henry Yount, or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for them do, well and truly administer according to law, and further do make or cause to be made, a true and just account of their said administration at or before the thirty first day of May, in the year of one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels, rights, and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said administrator's account, the same being first examined and allowed by the Circuit Court of the County where the said administration is granted, and shall deliver and pay to such person or persons respectively as the said court by their decree and sentence pursuant to the true intent and meaning of this act, shall appoint and direct and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the executor or executors therein named, do exhibit the same into the office of the said court making request to have it allowed and approved, and the said will is allowed and approved by said court, then if the said Sally Welker and Henry Yount within bounden, being thereto required, do render and deliver their said letters of administration, then this obligation to be null and void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force and effect

SOME EARLY MARRIAGES IN ST. VINCENTS' CATHOLIC CHURCH

CAPE GIRARDEAU, MISSOURI - 1831 - 1841

[Reprinted from *St. Louis Genealogical Society Quarterly* 17(3):92]

A mission church for its first several years, St. Vincent's drew most of its parishioners from the "American" Catholics who had begun to come into the area shortly after statehood. Some of these marriages were performed in Jackson, a leading population center of the period. [Editor's Note: The Vincentians continued to minister to the parish until 2006.]
