

## Lorena Shell Eaker 1927-2017

Lorena May Shell Eaker, 90, of Church Hill, Tennessee, honored local genealogist and honorary life member of the Society, passed away on September 16, 2017, in Kingsport, Tennessee. She was born on May 31, 1927, in Hahn, Missouri, daughter of Vernon E. and Hallie Fisher Shell. She and the late Odis Cleo Eaker were married June 27, 1942. He died June 3, 1990. Survivors include her daughter Cheryl (Cliff) Stanley of Mt. Carmel, Tennessee; brother Rick (Donna) Shell of Marble Hill; three grandchildren: Martin (Elana) Stanley of Tennessee, Trena (Jack) Hall of Utah, Melanie Stanley of Ohio; three greatgrandchildren: Sean Hall, Brianna Stanley, and Caleb Stanley. She was preceded in death by her husband and an infant, her parents, brothers Dale Shell and an infant brother, an infant sister, and an infant grandson. Memorials in her honor are suggested to the following: the National Alzheimer's Association; the Lincoln County, North Carolina, Genealogical Society; and the Bollinger County Public Library.

With the birth of their daughter Cheryl in 1947, she and Odis realized they didn't know enough family history when filling out the family Bible. This led them to a life-long study in the genealogy of Bollinger County and its early settlers from North Carolina. They soon realized they had shared ancestry through Casper Shell, one of the first settlers in Bollinger County from North Carolina in 1804, and Christian and John Peter Eaker, who arrived in 1817.

Years of study culminated in their first publication in 1976, *The Shoe Cobbler's Kin, A Genealogy of the Peter (Ecker) Eaker, Sr. Family (1701-1976)* and included over 42,000 names. In 1985 their continued research resulted in further detail in *The Shoe Cobbler's Kin, Volume II*, which included more than 49,000 names.

After her husband died, Lorena published *German Speaking People West of the Catawba River in North Carolina (1750-1800)* in 1994 including some 25,000 names. This publication traced the migration history of more than 600 immigrants from Europe to North Carolina to the early settlement of Southeast Missouri and Bollinger County culminating after 46 years of research.

With a thirst to make the connections in the genealogy, Lorena went on to take 55 years of study resulting in the publication in 2002 of *One Wise Man: A Genealogy of Frederick Wise of Lincoln County, NC, and His Descendants* which included more than 60,000 names. Realizing her research time was limited, she started scanning her files, putting as much as she could on CDs organizing by family names. Then in 2013 she gave all her files to the Lincoln County, North Carolina, Historical Society for use by others seeking their ancestry. She said, "I have more books in all of it, but I don't have time to write them all."

*Editor's Note*: Lorena included many clearly-labeled theories on relationships in *German Speaking Peoples*, intending these to be springboards for further research. Sadly, in an era where it is too easy to rehash information, many family historians have treated these as facts. I will miss working with Lorena and her extensive knowledge, but we do her honor by continuing her work, and not letting it stagnate.

Most such files are uninteresting, and have only a Receiver's Certificate and receipt. I did abstracts on files with signed documents only, and all of these related to buyers documenting their right to preemption (right of first offer because of residency on the tract by certain dates specified in the various national preemption laws. Signatures are reproduced unless buyers and witnesses signed with a mark.]




## HILL, William A. Biography Clinton County, Illinois

The ancestors of Mr. Hill came from North Carolina, and were among the early settlers of Missouri. His grandfather, Thomas Hill, was born in North Carolina, of Irish parentage. When he was seventeen years old, he became a soldier in the colonial army, in the Revolutionary war, took part in several battles, and served till the independence of the thirteen colonies was acknowledged by Great Britain. For some years he carried on a store in Lincoln county, North Carolina. He married Elizabeth WALKER, who was born in Lincoln county, North Carolina. She was the daughter of John Walker, who was also an old Revolutionary soldier. He was a patriotic man, who fought bravely against the British. The story is told of him that he one time secured permission to go home and see his family. On reaching his house, before he could dismount, the firing of guns was heard at Beatty's Ford, on the Catawba river and, merely speaking a word to his family without getting down from his horse, he hurried back to take part in the battle. Thomas Hill lived in North Carolina until an old man, and then removed to Cape Girardeau county, Missouri, where he died.

Henry Hill, son of Thomas Hill, and father of the subject of this sketch, was born in Lincoln county, North Carolina, on the 26th of October, 1809. In the year 1820, when eleven years old, he accompanied his grandfather, John Walker, from North Carolina to Missouri. His grandfather settled in Cape Girardeau county, Missouri, and there Mr. Hill was raised. He had gone to school three months in North Carolina. After coming to Missouri he had poor advantages for obtaining and education. The schools were held at irregular intervals in log school-houses, with puncheon floors and slat benches. He went to school and Cape Girardeau county, Missouri. On the 9th of January, 1829, he married Fanny WELTY, who was born in Cape Girardeau county, Missouri, in 1821. Her father, Daniel Welty, was born in North Carolina, and when a young man went to Kentucky, and there married Mary HENDRICKS. He afterward came to Missouri, and was one of the early settlers of Cape Girardeau county, Missouri, till 1874, and then moved to Illinois, and has since resided four miles north-east of Trenton.

William Alexander Hill, the oldest child now living of Henry and Fanny Hill, was born in Cape Girardeau county, Missouri, on the 28th of December, 1842. He was raised on a farm in that part of Missouri, and obtained his education in a district school in the immediate vicinity of his father's home. In the summer of 1862, the war of the rebellion then being in progress, he enlisted in the 8th Missouri Cavalry regiment, Confederate States army. He served under Gen. Sterling PRICE till the close of the war, taking part in campaigns in Missouri, Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas. He was in several engagements around Little Rock, and Biameta Bridge, and Helena, Arkansas; and Iron Mountain, Arrow Rock, and Independence, Missouri. From Independence he took part in a continued series of engagements through Missouri to Fort Scott, Kansas, where he was by the side of Gen. John S. MARMADUKE at the time of his capture by the Federal troops. After the close of war, he returned to the farm Cape Girardeau county, where he remained to the fall of 1865, when he came to Clinton county, where he engaged in farming. He was married on the 18th of May 8, 1871, to Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth DRAYTON, whose maiden name was RAMSEY, daughter of John H. Ramsey. In the spring of 1881, Mr. Hill became a resident of the town of Trenton, where he bought and improved property. He owns 240 acres of land, of which 160 is in Madison County. He is a democrat in politics and is warmly attached to the doctrines of that old and time-honored organization.


